1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how **[Your Name]**, trading as **[Business Name]** (“I”, “me” or “my”), uses cookies and similar technologies on this website (“the Website”).

By continuing to use the Website, you acknowledge that cookies may be used in accordance with this policy. Where required by law, I will ask for your consent before placing non-essential cookies on your device.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer, tablet or mobile device when you visit a website. They help websites function correctly, improve security and, where appropriate, provide information about how visitors use a website.

Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your device.

3. Types of Cookies Used

Essential Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the Website to operate properly. They enable basic functions such as security, network management and, where applicable, remembering your cookie preferences.

The Website cannot function correctly without these cookies.

Analytics Cookies (if enabled)

With your consent, I may use analytics cookies to understand how visitors use the Website. This information helps improve the Website’s performance and usability.

The information collected is generally aggregated and does not identify individual visitors.

Examples may include:

- the pages visited;
- the time spent on the Website;
- the type of browser or device used;
- how visitors found the Website.

If analytics cookies are not accepted, the Website will continue to function normally.

Contact Form

The contact form itself does not normally place cookies. However, if spam prevention technology (such as Google reCAPTCHA or Cloudflare Turnstile) is used, limited cookies may be set to help protect the Website from fraudulent or automated submissions.

4. Third-Party Services

The Website may use trusted third-party services which may place cookies on your device.

These services may include:

- website hosting providers;
- website analytics providers;
- spam protection services;
- embedded maps.

Each third party is responsible for its own privacy and cookie practices.

5. Managing Cookies

Most web browsers allow you to:

- view cookies stored on your device;
- delete cookies;
- block some or all cookies;
- receive notifications before cookies are stored.

Please note that disabling essential cookies may affect the operation of the Website.

Information about managing cookies can usually be found in your browser's Help section.

6. Consent

Where required under UK data protection and privacy laws, I will request your consent before placing non-essential cookies on your device.

You may withdraw or change your cookie preferences at any time using the cookie settings available on the Website, where provided.
